To introduce an Antitrust Compliance Programme in the process of Selection of Equipment for the Olympic Sailing Competition

<u>Proposal</u>

New Regulation - 23.1.10

23.1.10 When selecting equipment for the Olympic Sailing Competition the World Sailing Antitrust Compliance Programme shall be followed. Equipment shall not be selected as equipment for the Olympic Sailing Competition if it is not free to be produced by any interested person.

Current Position

- 1. To bring the current World Sailing rules and regulations in line with competition law.
- 2. To comply with anitimonopoly and antitrust laws and regulations in the European Union and worldwide.
