To clarify that **variable ballast** may also be movable.

Proposal

C.6.3 Boat Control Definitions

(e) BALLAST

Weight installed to influence the stability, flotation or total weight of the **boat**.

Ballast types:

(iv) VARIABLE BALLAST

Water **ballast** the amount of which may be varied. <u>It may be moved.</u>

Current Position

As above

Reason

- 1. Currently the ERS definition of **variable ballast** indicates that the amount of water ballast may be varied. It does not stipulate if it may be moved in its position
- 2. It is common practice amongst boats which carry water ballast to move the water either via pump or gravity between different tanks on the boat.
- 3. The proposal looks to clarify the position that water ballast may be varied in amount as well as adjusted in position.
- 4. This does not have any effect on RRS 51 as the ERS definition is only applicable if used by class rules where they would need to amend RRS 51.
