Proposal:

Regulation 16.1.5.(a) (iv) to be amended as follows:

16.1.5 (a)

<u>must</u> include-at least two events for men and two events for women designed to maximise excitement, innevation, public and media appeal; and for men and women each of the five disciplines, 1 person dinghy, 2 person dinghy, multi-hull, keelboat, windsurfer.

Current Position:

As above.

Reason:

- 1. This brings both genders better in line with number of athletes participating, as is occurring in other sports and is the wish of the IOC.
- 2. This format covers a range of skills, better representing sailing throughout the world, bearing in mind the constraints of an Olympic regatta.
- 3. It provides ISAF with a long term strategic view of Olympic competition from 2012 onwards.
