

**ISAF Youth Worlds Equipment**

Regulation 17.4.10

A submission from the Bermuda Sailing Association

**Proposal:**

That the boat used by single-handed females in the ISAF Youth Worlds event be changed to the Byte CII.

**Current Position:**

The boat currently used for the single-handed female event is the Laser Radial.

**Reason:**

The 2010 Youth Olympics will use the Byte CII in both the male and female single-handed events. This event is less than two years away; currently most of the youth single-handed events are being sailed in Laser Radials. Competition will be more successful for all if the boat is sailed more often in large events, such as the ISAF Youth Worlds. In addition we feel that the Byte CII is a more appropriate boat for young females, due to their lower body weight (120 – 140).
