## **Proposal**

- 18.3.1 In addition to the rights granted in Regulations 18.2 and 18.3 above, an International Windsurfing Class may hold a fourth World Championship as defined by the Class and approved by the ISAF
- 18.3.2 Alternatively to the rights granted in Regulations 18.2, 18.3 and 18.3.1 above, an International Windsurfing or Kiteboarding Class may hold a world championship in each of its disciplines for men, women, youth and masters.

## **Current Position**

As above.

## Reason

There is no current regulation covering multi-discipline classes

Windsurfing and Kiteboarding Classes are potentially multi-disciplined, meaning that independent competition formats exist within one class.

World Championship Title rights must exist for each discipline independently.
