

World Championship Events

Regulation 18.3

A submission from the International Kiteboarding Association

Proposal

18.3.1 In addition to the rights granted in Regulations 18.2 and 18.3 above, an International Windsurfing Class may hold a fourth World Championship as defined by the Class and approved by the ISAF

18.3.2 Alternatively to the rights granted in Regulations 18.2, 18.3 and 18.3.1 above, an International Windsurfing or Kiteboarding Class may hold a world championship in each of its disciplines for men, women, youth and masters.

Current Position

As above.

Reason

There is no current regulation covering multi-discipline classes

Windsurfing and Kiteboarding Classes are potentially multi-disciplined, meaning that independent competition formats exist within one class.

World Championship Title rights must exist for each discipline independently.
