

**Re-appointment of International Race Officials**

Regulation 33.6

A submission from the International Funboard Class Association

Proposal:

33.6 A candidate for re-appointment shall:

(a) apply directly to ISAF;

**(b) be recommended by the candidate's Member National Authority;**

~~(c)~~ **(c)** send the application on the official form so that it is received by the Secretary General by 1 September; and

~~(d)~~ **(d)** meet the general qualifications and the additional qualifications for the discipline concerned.

Reason:

An International Race Official can only become International race official thanks to the efforts and education he/she has received from his/her Member National Authority. Once appointed he/she should contribute, in return, to his/her MNA.

It is very important for an Member National Authority to keep in close contact with its nominated International Officers for:

- Education programs for the MNA's local National Officers
- Direct feedback to the MNA concerning race officials matters, such as new rules, regulations, policies, .....

Too many Race Officials, once appointed, turn their backs on their MNA and even have conflicts with them. An International Race Officer should of course stand above national politics but should remain active in his/her country.
