International Umpire - Regulation 31.12.1(b)

A submission from the Chairman of Race Officials Committee

### Purpose or Objective

To clarify that candidates for appointment as International Umpire must have consistently demonstrated the required qualifications.

## **Proposal**

- 31.12.1 A candidate for first appointment and re-appointment as an International Umpire shall:
  - (b) have **consistently demonstrated** the following qualifications:
    - (i) be able to apply the relevant rules and make correct decisions within a few seconds under pressure;
    - (ii) anticipation skills based on an understanding of how boats manoeuvre in match and /or team racing;
    - (iii) be able to drive and position small powerboats; and
    - (iv) be fit and able to withstand several consecutive days on the water in small powerboats;

#### **Current Position**

As above.

#### Reasons

- Some IU candidates mistakenly believe that if they in a single event demonstrate the
  required performance, they should be appointed as IUs. A good IU must be able to perform
  at the required level each time he/she is at an event. Otherwise, the competitors will suffer
  from incorrect umpire calls.
- 2. The purpose of this submission is to clarify that the required level must be consistently demonstrated.
