Age Limit for Race Officials at Major Events

A submission from the Royal Spanish Sailing Federation

Proposal

That there be an age limit of 65 years old for Race Officials appointed to Major Events.

Current Position

None

Reason:

- 1. 65 years old is the average age that normally a professional retires.
- 2. In many other sports this age limit is much lower due to physical reasons, efficiency, reflexes, etc.
- 3. Major events described in Regulation 18.12.15 (a) require a long period "on the water" and many hours driving a RIB (for example). After a long day "on the water" Race Officials will be weary and not as focused as at the beginning of the day.
- 4. Race Officials of 70 years old or more must renew their status every 2 years.
- 5. This age limit to apply to major events only.
