# **Racing Rules of Sailing**

Submission: 156-11

#### Rules 36 and P3

A submission from the Italian Sailing Federation

## Purpose or Objective

The purpose of the amendments proposed is to avoid different applications of penalties after a breach in rule 42

#### **Proposal**

#### 36 RACES RESTARTED OR RESAILED

If a race is restarted or resailed, a breach of a *rule*, other than rule 30.3 **and Appendix P**, in the original race shall not prohibit a boat from competing or, except under rule 30.2, 30.3 or 69, cause her to be penalized.

## P3 POSTPONEMENT, GENERAL RECALL OR ABANDONMENT

If a boat has been penalized under rule P1 and the race committee signals a *postponement*, general recall or *abandonment*, the penalty is cancelled, but it is still counted to determine the number of times she has been penalized during the regatta. <u>Following a second or subsequent penalty a boat shall not compete in a race which is restarted or resailed.</u>

#### **Current Position**

After a postponement, general recall or abandonment the a penalty imposed under rule P1 is cancelled and only counts to determine the total number of times she has been penalized during the regatta

## Reasons

- 1. When the existing Rule P3 and 36 are applied under Appendix P, a boat which breaches Rule 42 for the second or subsequent infringement is obliged to retire. In the event that the the race is, postponed, subject to a general recall or abandoned the boat may restart.
- 2. It thus appears that for the same infringement of a rule, two different consequences may result, which may affect significantly the results of the series.
- 3. Thus a boat may have attracted numerous penalties but still be able to race after a restart and gain a better result than the disqualification without a hearing which she would have been scored if the race had been completed.
