

Definitions Overlap

Question 1

A and X are overlapped and approaching a leeward mark that is to be left to port. Rule 17 does not apply. At position 3, X luffs and breaks the overlap. At position 4, X gybes onto port and, before she changes tack the boats become overlapped again. A maintains her course and hails "Starboard". X gybes to keep clear. There is a valid protest. What should the call be?



Answer 1

Before X gybes at position 4, a new overlap is established and A is now subject to rule 17. Although the boats are on opposite tacks after the gybe, rule 18 applies and the boats are therefore defined as overlapped. However, rule 17 does not apply because the boats are no longer on the same tack. No penalty.

Question 2

Would the answer be the same if X had not broken the overlap at position 3?

Answer 2

Yes.
