3. ISAF STRATEGIC PLAN

(a) Committee Terms of Reference, Skill Sets, Work Plan 2008-2012

- Noted the Committee Terms of Reference and skill sets for the Race Officials Committee submitted to the Executive Committee for the term of office November 2008 – November 2012
- (ii) Discussion on the four year work plan for the Race Officials Committee for the period November 2008 – November 2012. Agreed that the IMSC objects shall include better education of measurers on ERS etc, helping classes get organized regarding class rules, measurer networks and that a submission to the ROC shall be prepared regarding equipment control in ISAF Grade 1 events. A working party shall be formed to prepare the recommendations before March 2008.

(b) Progress Reports, Objective 4, Race Officials

Presentation by the chairman on

6. KEY AREAS TO PROGRESS IN 2008

(a) Equipment Control Sub-Committee

We discussed the working relationship with the Equipment Control Sub-Committee and noted the problems created from the publication of the IM Manual and agreed that the IMSC will propose to the EQSC a joint working party. This would be established to address the issue of a common Measurement document including the guide to measurement and material from the IM Manual.

(b) Classes, MNAs

The relationships between classes, MNAs and ISAF on measurement issues was discussed. A great number of MNAs are not active in Measurement, Certification & training so we discussed how the committee could overcome this.

(c) Equipment Rules for Sailing

Great concern was expressed about the last minute amendment of Submission 062-07. The latest version will be circulated to IMSC members for review.

(d) IM Code of Conduct

The Code of conduct will be integrated with the ISAF RO Code of conduct.

(e) Criteria for Appointment as IM

The criteria for appointment as an IM was briefly discussed; working party to be created for reviewing the current situation and proposing amendments.

(f) MNAs

It was agreed that the Technical Offices of each MNA shall be invited to future seminars and clinics to improve information exchange and cooperation.

7. INTERNATIONAL MEASURERS SEMINAR/CLINIC PROGRAMME

(a) Seminar / Clinic Programme 2007

- (i) Noted that joint IJ, MR and IM clinics were held in Mumbai, India in January 2007, IM instructor was Barry Johnson.
- (ii) Noted that Measurement clinics were held in May 2007 in Brazil and in October 2007 in Qatar. IM Instructor for both was David Sprague and he was assisted in Brazil by Alex Finsterbusch

(b) Clinic / Seminars in association with Regional Games

- (i) Noted that no requests were received to host clinics in association with Regional Games in 2007 although the Brazil seminar was partially held to assist the Brazil organizers and was run a month in advance.
- (ii) Noted that Regional Games do not take place in the year of the Olympic Regatta therefore the next possibility will be in 2009

(c) Seminar / Clinic Programme 2008 and beyond

Agreed to work on the schedule and promotion of the IM seminar / clinic programme in 2008 and beyond. There is currently a Seminar planned for January 2008 in Brussels. The plan is to have at least one seminar and one clinic per year in various parts of the world. We will be looking for a seminar or clinic in North America in 2008/9 and possibly one before the Madrid meeting.

(d) IM Conference 2007

Noted that the IM Conference took place in February 2007 in Southampton. There were 5 key projects identified to be worked on and chairs were appointed to start the work and are expected to report by the end of 2007.
