### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 01. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The 27<sup>th</sup> SEA Games Sailing Competition will be organized by the Myanmar Yachting Federation ( MYF ) with the support of the Myanmar Olympic Committee and the International Sailing Federation ( ISAF ).

#### 02. LANGUAGE

English shall be the official language, and if there is a conflict between languages the English text will prevail.

#### 03. RULES

The 27<sup>th</sup> SEA Games Sailing Competition will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ( RRS ).

The following rules, regulations and instructions will apply:

- 3.1 The SEA Games Federation Statutes and Rules
- 3.2 The 27<sup>th</sup> SEA Games Sailing Technical Handbook
- 3.3 The 27<sup>th</sup> SEA Games Sailing Notice of Race
- 3.4 The 27<sup>th</sup> SEA Games Sailing Instructions ( SI ) & Measurement Regulations which will be provided on or before 15 November 2013
- 3.5 The Rules of Respective Classes
- 3.6 No National Authority prescriptions will apply

#### 04. EVENTS

**05. ELIGIBILITY**

- 5.1 The Regatta is open only to teams representing the National Olympic Committee ( NOC ) affiliated to the SEA Games Federation ( SEAGF ).
- 5.2 Only competitors who comply with the conditions laid down in the SEAGF Statutes and Rules ( 2013 ) and the International Sailing Federation ( ISAF ) Rules are entitled to participate.
- 5.3 Entries are limited to one boat per national authority per event except Optimist Team Racing.
- 5.4 A maximum of twenty ( 20 ) competitors and Five ( 5 ) substitutes may be entered. Both sailors from the Optimist Boy and Girl divisions must be included for the Optimist Team Racing. In addition to the competitors, each country may register a maximum of ten ( 10 ) team officials.

**06. ENTRIES**

Entries by each participating country must be submitted in accordance with the regulation laid down by the 27th SEA Games Organizing Committee ( MYASOC ).

**6.1 Preliminary Deadline for Submission of Entry Forms by Number**

Preliminary Entry Forms by number from each participating country, forwarded through the respective National Olympic Committee ( NOC ), must be completed and should be received by MYASOC not later than 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 at 24:00 hours, Local Mean Time.

**6.2 Final Deadline for Submission of Entry forms by Name**

The Entry Form by Name must be received by MYASOC not later than 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2013 at 24:00 hours, Local Mean Time.

Both entries by Number and by Name may be sent by Fax or E-mail, but must subsequently be confirmed with the original documents, by registered airmail to the following address:

7.2 Twelve ( 12 ) races are scheduled. No warning signal will be made after 15:00 hours on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2013.

#### 08. ON-SITE REGISTRATION

Athletes shall complete and submit On-Site Registration Form at the Registration Office no later than 17:00 hours on 13<sup>th</sup> December 2013. Athletes not registered within this deadline will not be allowed to participate in the Regatta.

#### 09. MEASUREMENT

- 9.1 All boats and equipment shall be presented for measurement according to the measurement schedule.
- 9.2 Measurement checks may be made throughout the regatta on the instructions of the Chief Measurer ( CM ) or the International Jury ( IJ ).
- 9.3 Competitors are allowed to use only one set of equipment during the Event. The equipment must be measured and approved to be complying with the Class Rules by the Measurement Committee. Substitution of damaged equipment will be first cleared by the Chief Measurer and such substitution will be subject to the approval of International Jury. Substitution of damaged equipment may be permitted, after approval has been given by the International Jury or the Chief Measurer.
- 9.4 Half Rater class yachts chartered to use at the SEA Games 2013 shall be presented by drawn system. Each yacht is designed and manufactured in equalized, racing condition with the new Teak Hull, Teak Mast and Sails. These yachts and sails shall only be used at the 27<sup>th</sup> SEA Games 2013 Regatta and yachts sailed as presented with exception of admissible rig tuning to suit crews' weight and weather conditions.

#### 10. VENUE

- 10.1 The sailing competition will be held at the Ngwe Saung Yacht Club, Ayerwaddy Division, Myanmar.
- 10.2 Racing area will be in approximately 30 minutes sailing time from the launching area of Ngwe Saung beach.
- 10.3 The training venue will be the same as competition site.

#### 11. COURSES

The courses will be Trapezoid and Windward / Leeward courses.

#### 12. SCORING

- 12.1 The Low-Point Scoring System in Appendix A, modified by the SI, will apply.
- 12.2 Twelve ( 12 ) races are scheduled, of which one race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 12.3 If six ( 6 ) races are completed in an event, all races shall be counted.  
 12.4 When seven ( 7 ) to Nine ( 9 ) races have been completed, there shall be one ( 1 ) discard.  
 12.5 If ten ( 10 ) to twelve ( 12 ) races are completed, there shall be two ( 2 ) discards.

### 13. CHARTERED BOATS

- 13.1 Limited number of used yachts, boats and boards may be available to charter during SEA GAMES period. However, competitors must bring his/her own equipment during SEA GAMES.  
 13.2 Competitors using chartered boat must inform the Race Management Committee together with the Preliminary Deadline for Submission of Entry Forms by Number and should be received by MYASOC not later than 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 at 24:00 hours, Local Mean Time.

### 14. SUPPORT BOATS

- 14.1 Team leaders, coaches and all other support personnel are required to comply with the Myanmar SEA Games Sailing Competition Coach Boat Regulations.  
 14.2 Each country may bring their own coach boats.

### 15. BERTHING

Boats shall be moored or kept in their assigned or designated places.

### 16. ADVERTISING

- 16.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If required, boats shall display it in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.  
 16.2 Race Management Committee may occasionally and/or randomly, select a yacht, a boat or a board and secure with GPS or camera or any electronic devices for broadcasting and/or advertising purposes.

### 17. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

A Boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

### 18. TRANSPORTATION

Transportation will be provided by the Organizing Committee during the entire duration including pick up and drop off to the airport.

### 19. MISCELLANEOUS

Each team is requested to bring its own:  
 - National Flag (100cm x 250cm)  
 - National Anthem recorded on CD

### 20. CLEARING / FORWARDING AGENT

**22. PRIZES AND COMMENDATION**

22.1 Participants receiving awards must wear their National Uniforms.

22.2 The following prizes will be awarded for each class:

First Prize : Gold Medal and Diploma  
 Second Prize : Silver Medal and Diploma  
 Third Prize : Bronze Medal and Diploma  
 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> prizes : Diploma

If there are less than 4 entries in a class, a bronze medal shall not be awarded.

**23. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participating in the competition entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4.0 RSS Decision to race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the competition.

**24. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of US\$ 50,000.00 or the equivalent.
