

Sailing World Championships Test Event Qualification System 7 – 13 August 2017: Aarhus, DENMARK

Amended on 21 March 2017

1. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 1.1 Competitors and coaches shall enter by completing the on-line entry form on the World Sailing registration system and by paying the required fees.
- 1.2 On-line entry opens on 1 April 2017. MNA Priority Entries must be received no later than 1 May 2017. MNA Additional Entries must be received no later than 1 July 2017.
- 1.3 World Sailing Eligibility shall apply. Each athlete shall be registered as a World Sailing Sailor on the World Sailing website: www.sailing.org/isafsailor
- 1.4 Unless otherwise approved by the IOC or the World Sailing Executive, each competitor shall be a national of the country of the Member National Authority (MNA) which enters the boat or endorses the person in charge (as defined by RRS 46). This requirement does not apply to a crew member who receives approval to compete in the regatta from the MNA of the person in charge. Each competitor shall present proof of their nationality or the approved waiver at registration.
- 1.5 Olympic gender requirements will apply for each Olympic event.
- 1.6 Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration form at registration. The forms will be available for download on the event website.
- 1.7 Competitors shall produce evidence of membership of the appropriate class association at the time of registration as may be required by the Organising Authority.

- 2.1 Each MNA is entitled to one Priority Entry in each event. The event quota may be increased to allow each MNA at least one entry. The OA may also increase the event quota for the Laser and Laser Radial Class, with the approval of World Sailing, to ensure that all participants of the Emerging Nations Programme are able to compete.
- 2.2 Additional Entries in each event will be accepted, as follows, until the quota is filled:
 - (a) One place awarded to the host MNA.
 - (b) One place, awarded in MNA Priority Order, for each MNA with a remaining entry application.
 - (c) Repeat 2.2(b) above until the quota is filled
- 2.3 The Additional Entries of MNAs for each event will be sorted in Priority Order, based on the order of each MNA's highest appearance in each event of the World Sailing Rankings as of 1 July 2017.
