

## OVERVIEW OF MAJOR CHANGES TO THE ISAF CONSTITUTION

### AS APPROVED BY THE ISAF GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN NOVEMBER 2004

There follows a brief explanation of the major changes made by the ISAF General Assembly in November 2004. Please refer to the specific regulation for the actual wording, the explanation below is purely intended as a guide:

New Article 2.2	<i>New Article detailing that disputes are governed by English Law.</i>
<b>Cancellation of Membership</b>	
Articles 19-25	<i>Articles deleted. Subsequent Articles have been renumbered.</i>
<b>Language</b>	
Article 29	<i>Updated to include a reference to 'Plain English'.</i>
<b>The Council</b>	
Article 39.1(d)	<i>Amendment to Chairman of ISAF Offshore Committee.</i>
New Article 39.1(h)	<i>Inclusion of 20% minimum Women's representation on Council.</i>
<b>Powers of the Council</b>	
Article 46	<i>Clarification of the votes required for Council decisions.</i>
Article 47	<i>Clarification of secret ballot by electronic voting.</i>
<b>Proceedings of the Council</b>	
Article 62	<i>Clarification of minutes and queries relating to the minutes.</i>
<b>Review Board</b>	
Article 75	<i>Clarification of the Constitution of the Review Board.</i>
Article 77	<i>Clarification of the Authority Functions of the Review Board.</i>
Article 78	<i>Clarification of the Procedure of the Review Board.</i>
