

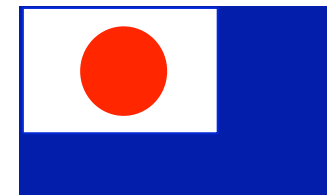

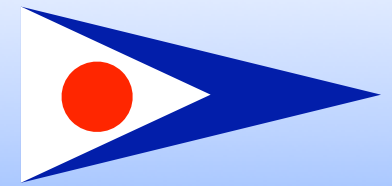

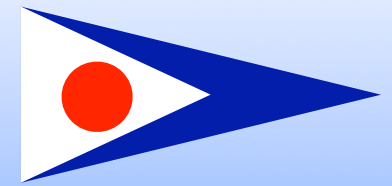
SPORTS FOR TOMORROW

The goal is to spread values learned through sports and increase awareness of the Olympic and Paralympic movement to people of all generations worldwide.

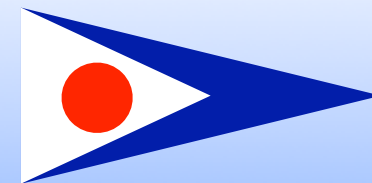

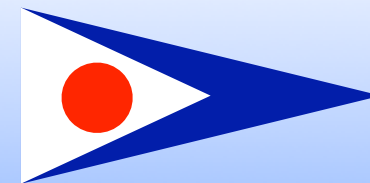
Olympic Class Sailing Clinic

While the Japanese coach provided instruction on technique, efforts were made to establish a personal network and reinforce relations.

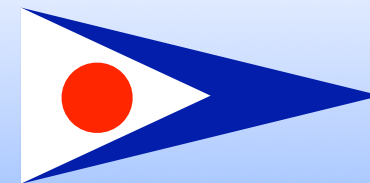
Olympic Class Sailing Clinic

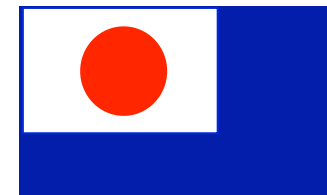

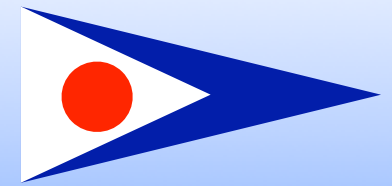

← **Mt. Fuji**

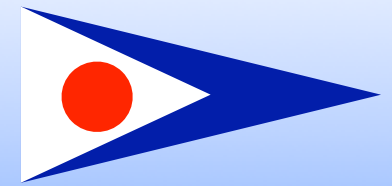

Narita Airport ⇒ Enoshima : 2.5 h

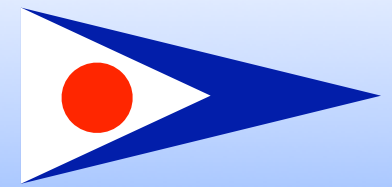
Haneda Airport ⇒ Enoshima : 1.5 h

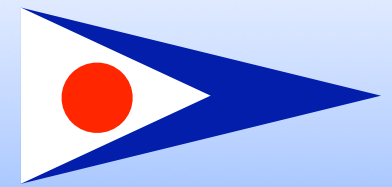

ENOSHIMA Yacht Harbor



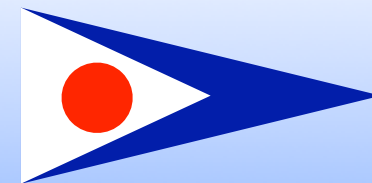
Main Building renewed in 2014

Weather : Mostly sunny

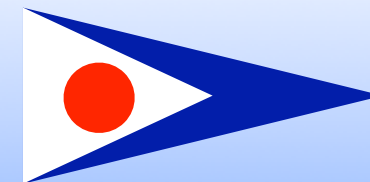
***Chance to shower in high temperature**

Humidity : Very high humidity 80-100%

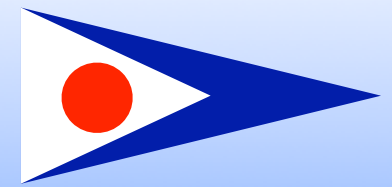
***Typhoon : Ave 0.9 times of Typhoon access in Aug**

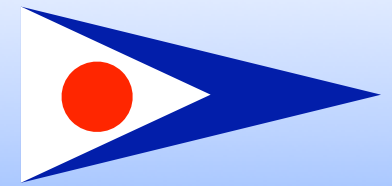
