Please give a short report of the World Championships	<p>1) QUALITY OF EVENT ORGANISATION?</p> <p>Argentina was going through a difficult time - political unrest, financial problems, riots, and several presidential changes. Communication with the event organisers was difficult until about 2 months prior to the event.</p> <p>On the water, the races were well organised and conducted fairly. Shore based officials were friendly and helpful.</p> <p>There were problems with arranging third party insurance requirements specified in the Notice of Race. This was eventually sorted out towards the end of the regatta.</p> <p>2) VENUE SUITABILITY FOR FUTURE WORLDS?</p> <p>ASHORE: Good facilities, but infrastructure in Argentina is currently in a difficult phase.</p> <p>AFLOAT: Shallow for anything other than small dinghies.</p> <p>3) STANDARDS/ LEVEL OF RACING? Good</p>
