Please give a short report of the World Championships	<p>1) QUALITY OF EVENT ORGANISATION? The running of the sailing was excellent. The race committee did a magnificent job and set true courses.</p> <p>2) VENUE SUITABILITY FOR FUTURE WORLDS? No ASHORE: All boats were stored on the hard asphalt in a marina. No shade was available for competitors. This was not the preferred site for the Worlds as unfortunately the organising yacht club pulled out of the event only a few months before the planned date. AFLOAT: The launching and retrieval through the marina could have been dangerous if there had of been heavy breezes. The water was dirty with lots of floating rubbish such as rubbish bins, wooden pallets, floating plastic bags & faeces and general rubbish.</p> <p>3) STANDARDS/ LEVEL OF RACING? The on-water race control was excellent and the standard of racing was world class. The winds were generally light to moderate.</p>
