Minimum quota for all Olympic Events

Purpose or Objective

The objective of this submission is to set a minimum quota for all 2020 Olympic sailing events

Proposal

For the 2020 Olympic Games, the quota shall not be inferior to 20 for any sailing event. This is not addressing any additional medal(s) or showcase event(s).

Current Position

In the 2016 Olympic Games, sailing events quota were all equal to or above 20.

Reasons

- A quota of 20 is a strict minimum for allowing representation and a competitive sailing fleet. Sailing is a global sport and the Olympic Games needs to deliver aspiration to as many countries worldwide as possible with a choice if events suited to the sailing culture and physiques of sailors around the world.
- 2. The earlier decision to allocate Continental quota places is lowering the quota places awarded to the best sailors.
- 3. For the 2016 Olympic Games, Events Committee had voted a policy to have a minimum of 20 quota places per event.
