The following amendments to the Class Rules have been approved to be effective 1st March 2001.

Shroud anchorages

Rule B 12.2

Amendment: “With the mast stepped and shrouds attached, the point of intersection of the line of the shrouds and the surface of the mast shall not be more than 150 mm above the lower edge of band No. 3. The distance between the points of intersection of the line of the shrouds with the deck or rubbing strakes shall be not less than 1270 mm. The points of intersection with the deck or rubbing strakes shall be not more than 45 mm outside the sheerline.”
