Proposal

Men's Board or Kite Board Windsurfer - Evaluation Women's Board or Kite Board Windsurfer - Evaluation Men's 1P Dinghy - Laser Women's 1P Dinghy - Laser Radial Men's 2nd 1P Dinghy - Finn Men's Skiff - 49er Women's Skiff - Evaluation Women's Keelboat - Elliott 6m Mixed Multihull - Evaluation Mixed 2P Dinghy (Spinnaker) - 470

Current Position

Men's Board or kite Board - Evaluation Women's Board or kite Board- Evaluation Men's 1P Dinghy - Laser Women's 1P Dinghy - Laser Radial Men's 2nd 1P Dinghy - Finn Men's Skiff - 49er Women's Skiff - Evaluation Women's Keelboat - Elliott 6m Mixed Multihull - Evaluation Mixed 2P Dinghy (Spinnaker) - 470

Reasons

- 1. The IOC recognises that Windsurfing and Kiteboarding are two distinct and different disciplines.
- 2. Combining two such distinct and different disciplines in one event will confuse the spectators and the media.
- 3. A Combined discipline event of both kiteboards and windsurfers would increase costs to MNA's, and significantly reduce one of the main attractions of windsurfing as a single discipline event.

- 4. Windsurfing must retain two medals as it is the most cost effective option available to men and women.
- 5. Windsurfing is an athletic, attractive and universally popular sailing discipline.
- 6. Windsurfing has an established, clear and universally accepted pathway from junior and youth to Olympic level.
- 7. Windsurfing is one of the most popular sailing disciplines, among MNA's, the media and the competitors.
- 8. The RAC strongly supports the inclusion of Kiteboarding in the Olympic Regatta and requests that ISAF asks the IOC for an additional event/medal.
