ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing - Reproduction policy

1. Ownership

ISAF is the owner of the Racing Rules of Sailing and has the right to publish the Racing Rules of Sailing and the <u>exclusive</u> rights to publish the Racing Rules of Sailing on the <u>internet</u> and the rights to all derivative works.

2. ISAF will license the use of the Racing Rules of Sailing as below:

(a) Rights granted to MNAs

- (i) ISAF has automatically, without fee licensed MNAs the right to use and publish the Racing Rules of Sailing within their territory and allows MNAs to derive an income through a cover price or advertising provided that:
 - (a) no MNA shall exploit the brand sector of ISAF's principal Racing Rules of Sailing Sponsor, presently watches and chronometers; and
 - (b) no MNA sponsor or advertiser shall claim or imply any commercial relationship with ISAF
- (ii) ISAF has automatically without fee granted MNAs the right to permit clubs affiliated to each MNA to use part or whole of the Racing Rules of Sailing for non-commercial use amongst the club's members.

(b) Commercial Publication

(i) Any organization, that wishes to use part of whole of the Racing Rules of Sailing in a commercial publication will be charged by ISAF, which will be based upon the retail price and print-run. It is the responsibility of the MNA to inform ISAF of any such arrangements.

3. Use of the ISAF logo and title

The ISAF logo shall be used on the front cover of all MNA reproductions of the Racing Rules of Sailing. The ISAF logo shall be no less than 15% of the length of the front cover page and can be placed where it suits the artwork. The ISAF logo shall be produced on a background of contrasting colour and in accordance with the ISAF logo guidelines. These can be located on the ISAF website at www.sailing.org

To avoid misunderstanding, the title 'Racing Rules of Sailing' should not be placed directly under or close to an MNA logo or title in such a way that it could denote title ownership by the MNA of the Racing Rules of Sailing.
