

## **Racing Rule Changes Authorised by ISAF under Rule 86.2**

**2011**

### **1. Faerder Regatta – Norway 17-19 June 2011 to add a new rule, 42.3(i) for the Formula 18 Class**

42.3(i)

'Means of propulsion: Paddling is permitted, but only with one or two single paddles (double paddles are not allowed). The paddle shall not be longer than 1.6 meters. Connecting two single paddles to make a double paddle is forbidden. Rowing is not permitted. For the purpose of limiting the paddling; each time, when a team starts to paddle, the gennaker has to be completely furled or down, with no sail area exposed. This rule applies even for short time paddling or paddling to avoid an obstruction.'

### **2. 2011 Extreme Sailing Series**

- 2.1 ISAF approves under RRS 86.2 that; RRS 88.1 and 88.2 be deleted and replaced with; 'The prescriptions of national authorities will not apply.'
- 2.2 allow the use of Addendum Q in all jurisdictions.
- 2.3 Racing Rule 18.3; use of the match-racing version of Rule 18.3 (Rule C2.6).

### **3. Volvo Ocean Race 2011-2012**

- 3.1 RRS 88.1 and 88.2 be deleted and replaced with: The prescriptions of national authorities will not apply.

- 3.2 Regulation 20.3.1.1 be changed to:

Each individual Competitor may, with the agreement of the Person in Charge, display Advertising on clothing and personal equipment without restriction except; the Volvo Ocean Race Trade Marks shall appear on both of the upper outer sleeves of all Crew Members' foul weather and mid-layer clothing. The area to be left clear for the placement of the logo shall be no less than; height 185 mm x width 150 mm. The colour and location of the logos shall be approved by the OA, (This amends ISAF regulation 20.3.1.1).

Regulation 20.3.1.2 be changed to:

Advertising chosen by the Person in Charge may be displayed on hulls, spars and sails without restriction except on the spaces reserved for identification by Appendix G of the Racing Rules and under Regulations 20.5 by Regulation 20.9 and Notice Of Race Appendix A. (This amends ISAF regulation 20.3.1.2).

- 3.3 Regulation 20.4.1.1 (a) be changed to:

The OA shall require Boats to display logos on the topsides, on both sides of the hull, aft of the bow. No other logo shall be used for this purpose than the OA supplied bow logos in its original shape, size, colour, material and form.

These logos are; height 1.40 m x width 1.10 m and shall be centred on the vertical centreline between the waterline and the deck level, using the outer measurement of the logo. The front edge of the logo shall be approximately 0.50 m from the bow. The first 2.0 m of the topsides

of both sides of the hull shall be a single uninterrupted colour. No other logo shall be placed within 1.0 m of the OA supplied bow logos. (This amends ISAF regulation 20.1.1. (a))
