### **Question**

A boat with an outstanding penalty takes the appropriate penalty

- a) within two hull lengths of Mark L when on leg 1 to Mark W, or
- b) within two hull lengths of Mark L when approaching the finishing line.

Has she correctly taken her penalty?

### **Answer**

Yes. Rule C7.3(b) does not permit a boat to take a penalty within two hull lengths of a rounding mark. However, for the purpose of rule C7.3(b), Mark L is not a rounding mark on the first beat or the final downwind leg.
