		Coaming	The part of the cockpit, including the transverse after limit, over which water would run when the boat is floating level and the cockpit is filled to overflowing includes the transverse after limit of the cockpit over which water would run in the event that when the yacht is floating level the cockpit is flooded or filled to overflowing.
		Moveable Ballast	Lead or other material including water which has no practical function in the boat other than to increase weight and/or to influence <u>Material carried for the sole purpose of increasing weight and/or influencing</u> stability and/or trim and which may be moved transversely but not varied in weight while a boat is racing.
		Permanently Installed	Means <u>The</u> item is effectively built-in by e.g. bolting, welding, glassing etc. and may not be removed for or during racing.
		Securely Fastened	Held strongly in place by a method (e.g. rope lashings, wing-nuts) which will safely retain the fastened object in severe conditions including a 180° degree capsizes and allows for the item to be removed and replaced during racing
