Purpose or Objective

To make it a requirement for a ship's EPIRB to include an internal GPS

Proposal

<u>It is recommended that a A 406Mhz EPIRB shall</u> include an internal GPS <u>when purchased after</u> <u>1st January 2015</u>, <u>it is recommended that they</u> also include a 121.5Mhz transmitter for local homing.

Reason

It is a recommendation that the EPIRB include an internal GPS.

The built in GPS receiver ensures that an accurate position of a casualty is relayed to the rescue services. This in turn improves the speed of recovery by updating the position of the beacon at regular intervals.
