

## INTERNATIONAL X-41 CLASS



The following amendments to the Class Rules have been approved to be effective 1<sup>st</sup> March 2013 by the Class Rules Sub-committee.

### Class Rule A.13.2

#### New Rule:

Change of ownership of a yacht shall invalidate the measurement certificate which shall be revalidated by the new owner. Prior to issuance of a new certificate, the yacht shall be inspected by a class measurer for compliance with class rules.

### Class Rule C.7.2(b)

#### New Rule:

"All yachts shall have antifouling paint applied over the entire underwater section of hull and hull appendages. This antifoul may be lightly sanded but shall not be removed."

### Class Rule C.10.5(d)

#### New Rule:

Mast jack shall not be onboard while racing.

### Class Rule C.10.9(d)

#### Amendment:

### Class Rule C.11.3(d)

#### Amendment: Replace existing wording

All Mainsail, Headsail, ISAF OSR Heavy Weather Jib and Spinnaker carried aboard while racing shall have a sail limitation stickers applied. The storm jib and storm trysails are not subject to purchase limitations.

A new boat may purchase sail limitation stickers from the ICA for base inventory of 1 mainsail, 2 headsails, 2 spinnakers, 1 ISAF OSR Heavy weather jib and an additional sail in the first calendar year of racing. Upto the 31st December 2011 a boat is then permitted five (5) new class sails per calendar year which shall be affixed to sails initially certified before the 31st of December of that year.

## INTERNATIONAL X-41 CLASS



From the 1st January 2012 a boat is then permitted four (4) new class sails per calendar year which shall be affixed to sails initially certified before the 31st of December of that year.

A Charterer may use the with sail sticker limitation to the charter boat. If an X-41 owners charters a boat were his boat does not compete he may use either the sails from his boat or that of the charter boat.

A boat may apply for additional sail limitation stickers to replace ones of sails destroyed beyond repair during while the boat is under charter or during the first 12 months.
