Submission **35-00**

**ISAF REGULATION 7.10 ENTRY IN WORLD AND CONTINENTAL
CHAMPIONSHIPS**

A submission from the Real Federacion Espanola de Vela dated 28 July 2000

Proposal

For all World and Continental Championships under Regulation 7.2, entries shall be made in accordance with the rules set out by the relevant International Class Association through the respective MNA's.

Reason

There are too many world and continental championships, with many of them having little or no relevance. In many of them the entry is permitted to sailors who say they represent a particular country, though without the approval of the National Authority, and very often against the established rules of their federation and the laws of their country. Moreover, in these cases, they are sailors without any insurance, which could lead to liabilities being incurred by their respective MNA and the competition organisers.

Recommendation to Council November 2000 - Minute 3(a)(xx)

Recommendation

The Executive Committee recommends Council reject Submission 35-00 as it is a matter for the individual Member National Authorities, not ISAF.

Council Decision

Whilst the submission was generally supported, it was deferred to the 2001 Mid-Year Meeting of Council and the Executive Committee will appoint a working party

Recommendation to Council May 2001 – Minute 5(i)

Recommendation

Council noted the submission and recommendations from November 2000, and the Council decision of November 2000 that the Executive Committee appoint a working party to make a recommendation to the 2001 Mid-Year Meeting.

However, the Executive Committee reported that in view of the work being undertaken by the Events Committee “Event Strategy Working Party”, that Submission 35-00 be referred to the working party to consider.

Council Decision

That the Event Strategy Working Party be charged with considering submission 35-00 and make a recommendation in November 2001.
