## Submission 088-04 – Appointment of Race Officials – Country Designation

## **Proposal 1:**

Delete existing Regulation 33.7, and insert the following:

- 33.7 The list of International Judges shall be printed in the ISAF Yearbook. When appointed or reappointed, an International Judge shall receive a Certificate of Appointment.
- 33.7 The list of International Judges shall be printed in the ISAF yearbook together with their country, which shall be their country for all purposes in the Racing Rules of Sailing and the Regulations.
- 33.7.1 On reappointment, the designated country shall be the same unless:
  - (a) the person concerned has removed his principal residence to another country; and
  - (b) <u>has complied with all the requirements of that country if any as to licensing, insurance and otherwise; and</u>
  - (c) <u>has received the consent of the former MNA and the new MNA to change his or her designation in which case the new MNA shall be his designated country:</u>
- 33.7.1. If an International Judge has removed his or her principal residence to another country and has complied with all respect with regulation 33.7.3 except that one of the two MNAs has not given its consent to the change, he may apply to the Appointments Working Party for settlement of the issue. The Appointments Working Party shall consider representations in writing of all the parties and make its decision on the basis of what is fairest to all the parties concerned. It shall publish its written report to the parties and to the Executive Committee.

## **Proposal 2:**

The Constitution Committee recommends that clauses in precisely the same terms, except that the reference should be to the relevant discipline, should be inserted in Regulation 34, 35 and 36 to deal with Umpires, Measurers and Race Officers respectively.

## Note:
