ISAF Youth Sailing World Championship

A submission from the Executive Committee

Proposal:

The Executive Committee proposes a minimum age for participation in the ISAF Youth Sailing World Championship by making the following amendment to regulation 17.2.3:

17.2.3. To be eligible to participate in the Championship, all competitors shall be under the age of 19 years <u>and over the age of 14 years</u> on 31 December of the year of the Championship.

Reason:

The Executive is concerned that the pressures on young sailors participating in this Championship can be very high and that a high age gap between the participants is to be avoided.
