1.1 Distribution - The ISAF have received a listing of registered boat owners in the following countries with the following principle distribution of boat owners:

France 400

Peru 25

Thailand 312

This satisfies the requirement for Recognized Status under regulation 26.2.1.(e).

- 1.2 Class Rules The ISAF have received a copy of the class rules currently used by the class including proposed amendments for 2005. The Class Rules are not in ISAF Standard format, and therefore the Class are working with ISAF to convert them to ISAF Standard format which shall be completed by 1st March 2003.
- 1.3 Constitution The Constitution has been reviewed by the Constitution Committee and amendments implemented.
- 1.4 Class Organisation Active Class organisations have been established in France, Peru and Thailand, including established Youth programmes. The class is developing in other nations including the USA.

Current manufacturers are BIC Sport (France) and Starboard (Thailand). All boards are ISAF Approved Series Production Boards including the Bic Techno, Techno Formula, Starboard 136 and the Starboard 156.

The class held their first European Championships 12th-17th August in Portugal with 64 entrants from Belgium, Canada, France, Germany, Great Britain, Italy, Mauritius, Netherlands Antilles, Poland, Portugal, Russia, Spain, Thailand and the USA.
