Regulation 7

Proposal:

A candidate for President of ISAF who fails to get elected President can, at his or her option, stand for election for Vice President.

Current Position:

At present there is no mechanism within Section 7 (Election of President and Vice-Presidents) of the ISAF Regulations which allows a candidate for President to stand for Vice President if he or she fails to get elected President.

Reason:

Most candidates for President of ISAF have, over many years, worked for ISAF and gained invaluable experience which would be very useful to the organization if said individual were elected Vice President. It is a great loss to ISAF that most failed presidential candidates cease to be active in ISAF.
