

**Court of Arbitration Waiver**

Regulation 19.2(c)

A submission from the Executive Committee

**Proposal:**

To amend Regulation 19.2(c) as follows:

- (c) (i) be registered as an 'ISAF Sailor' on the ISAF Website; and for those events listed under 19.3(a), (b) and (c), Olympic Qualification Events and ISAF Graded Match Racing Events.
- (ii) ~~sign the waiver from the Court for Arbitration in Sport~~  
~~For those events listed under 19.3(a), (b) and (c), Olympic Qualification Events and ISAF Graded Match Racing Events.~~

**Current Position:**

- (c) (i) be registered as an 'ISAF Sailor' on the ISAF Website; and
- (ii) ~~sign the waiver from the Court for Arbitration in Sport~~  
For those events listed under 19.3(a), (b) and (c), Olympic Qualification Events and ISAF Graded Match Racing Events.

**Reason:**

1. It is impossible for ISAF to implement the waiver for all sailors participating at Regional Games.
2. ISAF can implement the requirements of Regulation 19.2(c)(ii) via the Notice of Race for events detailed under 19.3(a) and (c), Olympic Qualification Events and ISAF Graded Match Racing Events.
3. It is questioned whether the waiver has legal standing in some legal environments.
4. The waiver may confuse the status of the RRS as the final body of appeal for all issues governed by the RRS.
