# Olympic Regatta, Selection of Windsurfing Equipment

A submission from the Royal Spanish Sailing Federation

#### PROPOSAL:

To carry out a selection process (such as the one done for the 49er) for the Olympic Board 2008 on the understanding that:

- It should be constructed as per the class rules and not under a fabrication monopoly.
- It should be a long board.
- It should have a sliding keel (daggerboard).

## **CURRENT POSITION:**

No current position.

### **REASON:**

- 1. The fabrication monopoly should be eliminated in order to reduce the buying cost.
- 2. Comments on Formula Windsurfing
  - Its large sail area makes it impossible for juniors to sail in this class.
  - Women cannot race in this class due to weight needs.
  - The need of several masts and sails make it imperative to start with a big expense and to have a personal coach on the water with all the equipment.
  - It is impossible to sail in normal conditions with a wind of 10 knots or less.

## 3. Mistral

- Design and performance should be improved.
- There is no quality control in the fabrication and commercialization of the board despite its strict class rules
- Advantages of a new long board:
- Updated design, construction and performance.
- Possibility of building it in any country complying with the class and ISAF rules.
- Possibility of junior sailing with the same board and a smaller sail and mast.
- > Smaller costs of purchase and competition.
- Increase the tactical possibilities.
