# Racing Rules of Sailing On the Same Tack: Proper Course

## A submission from the Royal Yachting Association

#### PROPOSAL:

### 17 ON THE SAME TACK; PROPER COURSE

**17.1** If a boat *clear astern* becomes *overlapped* within two of her hull lengths to *leeward* of a boat on the same *tack*, she shall not sail above her *proper course* while they remain *overlapped* within that distance, unless in doing so she promptly sails astern of the other boat the *overlap* is promptly broken. This rule does not apply if the *overlap* begins while the *windward* boat is required by rule 13 to *keep clear*.

#### **CURRENT POSITION:**

#### **REASON:**

The words 'sails astern of the other boat' are often ambiguous in a multiple boat overlap. The proposal uses the defined word 'overlap' to clarify when a boat subject to this rule may sail above a proper course.
