Proposal:

To delete the Mistral from the list of equipment for the Windsurfing boys and girls disciplines from 2007 and onwards.

Current Position:

Regulation 17.4.10:

- 17.4.10 The Classes for the ISAF Youth Sailing World Championship are:
- Single-handed Dinghy boys - Laser or Laser Radial
 - Single-handed Dinghy girls - Laser Radial or Byte
 - Double-handed Dinghy boys - 420 or 29er
 - Double-handed Dinghy girls - 420 or 29er
 - Windsurfing boys - Mistral
 - Windsurfing girls - Mistral
 - Multihull Open - Hobie 16 with spinnaker

Reason:

Until the testing of the youth rig sizes of the Neil Pryde RS:X (see separate submission) is complete, the Mistral equipment needs to remain on the list in 2006.

Removing the Mistral from 2007 onwards provides direction on the equipment to be used for the Championship and gives clear guidance to the MNA's which equipment to choose for its national youth windsurfing programmes.
