Adoption of new equipment and a new name for the Aloha Class

A submission from the Aloha Class

PROPOSAL:

The Aloha Class, an ISAF "Recognised" class wishes to change its class rules so that

- 1. New One-Design equipment can be adopted;
- 2. They comply with the ISAF Standard Class Rule format and the ERS (new Rules attached where appropriate):
- 3. The class shall be known as te "U15 Windsurfing Class".

CURRENT POSITION:

The current class rules do not comply with the ISAF standard class rule format and require the use of Bic Aloha One-Design equipment.

REASON:

- 1. Bic has ceased production of the Aloha;
- 2. The class staged a successful trial at its world championship at the beginning of August 2004 in which 5 different sets of equipment from 3 different producers were tested. At the subsequent Annual General Meeting of the Class, the decision was taken to select the Board and Rig as One-Design equipment for use by the class;
- 3. A more generic name, which better describes the target age group of the class and its desire to be seen by MNAs as the universal training and development class for MNAs wishing to develop windsurfing in their countries, is thought more appropriate.
