Requirements for Re-appointment

**Proposal:**

New Regulation 36.2 (d)

The applicant shall be older than 25 years old and younger than 65 years old.

This new rule will affect other ISAF regulations.

**Current Position:**

None

**Reason:**

For 25 years old: At the age of 25 sailors might have acquired enough experience in order to become an Race Officer.

For 65 years old: The current international events require from the Jury to be on the water long time onboard of RIB's.

Many times these situations are in very strong meteorological conditions and the capacity of concentration and physical from this age could be altered for a good judging. (ie: RRS 42, etc)
