PROPOSAL:

Amend Class Rule 3.2.6(iv) as follows:

After satisfying the buoyancy test... a pressure-equalizing hole, made with a nominal 2 mm 1 mm drill may be provided...

CURRENT POSITION:

See above.

REASON:

For pressure equalizing, when the boats heats up in the sun or cools down in the night, a hole of 1 mm is enough.

Actually, this rule is practically not used; sailors are used to open the covers after racing and for transport.

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
