Class Rule Change

A submission from the International Europe Class

PROPOSAL:

New Rule:

None but enter in the Measurement Form Centreboard at item 3.5:

Is each side of the top of the board fitted with battens or stops ***of minimum 5 mm height*** so that no part of the board within 50 mm from the top, except within 20 mm of each edge can enter the centreboard case slot?

CURRENT POSITION:

Existing Rule:

Class Rule Centreboard Measurement Notes 5:

A batten of wood or GRP, or stops of wood, rubber or plastic, not less than 5 mm high shall be fitted to each side of the top of the board.

REASON:

To make it easier for sailors at repairs and for measurers at first measurements to comply with the existing rule.
