Class Rule Change

J/24 Rule 2.7.1 (Measurement)

A submission from the International J/24 Class Association

PROPOSAL:

To amend the Rule as follows:

Yachts shall only be measured by a National Measurer recognized the International J/24 Class Association. This applies to all references of “J/24 Measurer” or “J/24 Class Measurer” in the Class Rules.

CURRENT POSITION:

Yachts shall only be measured by a measurer recognized by Its National Authority and the International J/24 Class Association.

REASON:

1. To insure that the National Measurer is familiar with the J/24 Measurement Manual (Rule 2.8.1)
2. To be consistent with new Rule 2.5.3. The Measurement Certificate required by the IJCA is “in addition to any certificates required by the owner’s national authority”. If the owner’s national authority requires a different certificate, it is not at issue with the IJCA.
3. To avoid changing references to measurers throughout the body of the current rules.
