Class Rule Change

J/24 Rule 2.7.1 (Measurement)

A submission from the International J/24 Class Association

PROPOSAL:

To amend the Rule as follows:

Yachts shall only be measured by a National Measurer recognized the International J/24 Class Association. This applies to all references of "J/24 Measurer" or "J/24 Class Measurer" in the Class Rules.

CURRENT POSITION:

Yachts shall only be measured by a measurer recognized by Its National Authority and the International J/24 Class Association.

REASON:

- 1. To insure that the National Measurer is familiar with the J/24 Measurement Manual (Rule 2.8.1)
- 2. To be consistent with new Rule 2.5.3. The Measurement Certificate required by the IJCA is "in addition to any certificates required by the owner's national authority". If the owner's national authority requires a different certificate, it is not at issue with the IJCA.
- 3. To avoid changing references to measurers throughout the body of the current rules.
