Regulation 22 ISAF Classification Code

A submission from the chairman of the Constitution Committee

PROPOSAL:

That the preamble of the ISAF Classification Code be amended to read as follows:

The ISAF Sailor's Classification Code exists as a service to provide Events and Classes with an international system of classification for sailors.

Events and Classes are not under any obligation to use a classification system but should they wish to do so the ISAF Code is available is the only system that shall be used.

ISAF Classes using a system shall first obtain the approval of ISAF and shall only use the to use the ISAF Code.

The ISAF Code is not applicable to the Olympic Classes.

When the Code is selected for an event it shall be stated in the Notice of Race.

The display of advertising on a boat or equipment beyond Category A in the Advertising Code does not influence the sailors' classification in this code.

CURRENT POSITION:

REASON:

- To revise the Preamble to reflect that the Classification Code is now mandatory and the single system of professional/amateur classification being used in the sailing world.
- 2. To reflect that the Classification Code is applicable to all classes, whether or not they hold ISAF status.
