PROPOSAL:

H.9: SAFETY HARNESS and SAFETY LINES

Attention is drawn to ISO 12401 norms.

a) Safety harness:

Each crewmember shall have a safety harness.

A crewmember's harness and life jacket shall be compatible.

b) Safety lines (tethers):

Each harness shall be equipped with a safety line not more than 2m long with a snap hook at each end. In addition, at least 30% of the crew shall each be provided with either a safety line not more than 1m long, or a mid-point snap hook on a 2m safety line.

Attention must be drawn on U-bolts as clipping points, because they can lead unclipping plain snap hook. For this reason, the use of snap hooks with positive locking devices is strongly recommended.
