PROPOSAL:

Appendix U1: INTERNATIONAL FUNBOARD CLASS MEASUREMENT RULES

Delete current rule 4.2 and replace with the following:

4.2.a. Course Racing: The hull shall not exceed 3950mm in length and the width shall not exceed 1005mm

4.2.b. Slalom Racing: The hull shall not exceed 3950mm in length and the width shall not exceed 850mm

CURRENT POSITION:

Current rule:

4.2 The hull shall not exceed 3950mm in length and the width shall not exceed 1005mm.

REASON:

The limit on the width of the slalom board has been introduced so that current registered boards are not immediately made redundant by the introduction of ever wider boards. When the current maximum width of 1005mm was introduced in 2001, it was based on course board construction only.

These changes have been previously published by the IWA in 2003 but have not been ratified by the ISAF.
