

CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions are amended as follows:

8. Boats and Boards

8.1 All boats and boards will be provided for all competitors. Competitors with provided boats shall not modify them or cause them to be modified in any way except that:

- (i) For the 420 only: Competitors shall not untie the shrouds while afloat. ~~The spreader angle shall not be adjusted to a position where the forward hole in the spreader and the aftermost hole in the spreader bracket are being used.~~

17. Penalty System

17.1 For the Hobie 16 class, rule 44.1 **and 44.2** is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

19. Protests and Penalty System

19.2 For each ~~class~~ **event**, the protest time limit is 90 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day. The same protest time limit applies to all protests by the race committee and jury and to requests for redress. This changes rules 61.3 and 62.2.

20. Scoring

- 20.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her ~~two~~ **two** worst scores.
