Limiting Costs for Attendees – New Regulation 37.2

A submission from the Chairman of the World Sailing Classes Committee

Purpose or Objective

Annual Conferences & Annual General Meetings to be held in or close to major hubs with a range of available accommodation

Proposal

Amend Regulation 37.2 as follows:

The Board shall invite bids from interested venues and shall publish in advance the criteria against which the Board will assess any bids received. <u>Only venues in or close to major airport hubs</u> that offer accommodation options in all price ranges within reasonable walking distance to the conference venue shall be considered an eligible bid.

Current Position

As above.

Reason

- 1. Holding Annual Conference and Annual General Meeting in exotic locations and high class resorts puts a high financial burden on MNAs and Classes.
- 2. The venue selected should be in or close to a major international airport hub which can be reached through a wide range of intercontinental flights and does not require additional travel.
- 3. Many delegates, both from MNAs and Classes, have to cover the costs for attending the conferences themselves.
- 4. Flight costs to major airport hubs are usually lower than to small / regional airports.
- 5. A range of accommodation in the categories simple, average and high-end in reasonable walking distance to the conference venue should be available.
- 6. Both venues selected for the 2017 and 2018 conferences will be very expensive for MNAs and classes to attend due to travel requirements and the resort style of the venues.
