World Sailing Classes Committee – Terms of Reference – New Regulation 6.7.3(f)

A submission from the World Sailing Classes Committee

### Purpose or Objective

Appointment of a representative of the World Sailing Classes Committee to each of two newly created committees/sub-committees.

#### Proposal

Amend Regulation 6.7.3(f) as follows:

propose members to the Equipment Committee, Events Committee, Equipment Rules Sub-committee, <u>Development and Regions Committee</u>, Youth <u>Events Sub-Committee</u>, and International Measurers Sub-committee. The member proposed to the Events Committee shall be a representative from an Olympic class.

and to include the above provision in the Terms of Reference of the new committee and subcommittee.

#### **Current Position**

Regulations 6.7.3(f)

## Reason

- The above new committees have an expanded role in the implementation of World Sailing strategy. World Sailing Classes make a major contribution to the work of World Sailing in development, both regional and general, and in the promotion of youth sailing.
- 2. The inclusion of WSCC representatives was specified in the recommendations of the ICC to submissions 019-15, 021-15 and 024-15, and noted by Council.

These ISAF Classes Committee recommendations to Council in November 2015 stated:

The recommendation ref Submission 019-15:

"Amend 021-15 & 024-15 to include an ISAF Class Representative"

The recommendation ref Submission 021-15:

"The ISAF Classes Committee shall have a representative on the proposed Development & Regions Committee"

and the recommendation ref Submission 024-15:

 $\mathsf{Submission:}\, 006\text{--}17\, \mathsf{Cont'd}$ 

"The ISAF Classes Committee shall have a representative on the proposed Youth Events Sub-committee."

3. A submission to change the above regulation was drafted in 2016 but not submitted. WS Classes Committee representatives should have been elected (and proposed by the World Sailing Classes Committee) in November 2016.
