Purpose or Objective

To reduce all Direct Conflict of Interest for ISAF Executive and Committee Chairman positions in ISAF.

Proposal

Preamble to Part II of regulations: No ISAF Executive Committee member or Chairman of any ISAF Committee, within a month after getting elected, shall be paid by any MNA or any Government Authority in a country on regular basis (except reimbursement of logistics expenses) for services rendered to any ISAF MNA.

Current Position

As above

Reason

- 1. ISAF Executive Members and Committee members should be neutral in their decision capacity as ISAF is a MNA organisation.
- 2. Being a direct employee or on regularly paid individual will compromise the position of decision making in key positions in ISAF.
- 3. This rule should not be applied to all committee members as most committee members will have conflict of interest but the ISAF Executive and Chairman of the committees should follow the above.
