Racing Rules of Sailing

Definition Obstruction and Rule F20.1.(a)

A submission from the International Kiteboarding Association

Purpose or Objective

To apply the principle of "changing course of position of the kite" to obstructions

Proposal 1

Amend the first sentence of Appendix F Definitions – Obstruction as follows:

"An object that a kiteboard could not pass without changing <u>her</u> course <u>or position of her</u> <u>kite</u> substantially, if she were sailing directly towards it and 10 metres from it."

Proposal 2

Change Rule 20.1.(a) as follows:

"she can avoid the obstruction safely without making a substantial <u>change of her</u> course <u>or</u> <u>position of her kite change</u>"

Current Position

As above

Reason

In many rules for kiteboard racing the position of the kite is taking into consideration (as the sail = kite is separated several meters from the hull) and so should in the definition and rules about obstructions.
